New Application for Admission

Master of Business Administration – International Program

Academic Year 1/2026 (Round 1-2)

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Master of Business Administration – International Program for the academic year 2026.

1. Qualification of the Applicants

- 1.1 Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or higher degrees in any fields or majors from an accredited academic institution and have a TOEFL score of 500 PBT, 173 CBT and 61 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 or NIDA TOEFL ITP score of 500 or General English Test from NIDA TEAP score of 500 or
- 1.2 Applicants who are native speakers of English or who have completed undergraduate studies or higher degrees in English within 5 years prior to application \underline{or}
- 1.3 Applicants who have no scores from one of the English proficiency tests namely TOEFL score of 500 PBT, 173 CBT and 61 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 or NIDA TOEFL ITP score of 500 or General English Test from NIDA TEAP score of 500 can still apply for an interview to the program. The results of the interview will be judged by the applicants' English proficiency. Applicants who have been accepted through the interview-only method need to enroll in a basic English course in the first semester and submit their scores from one of the English proficiency tests within the first semester (before 15 December 2026).

If the applicant has no English test scores required by NIDA, or other English proficiency evidence, the applicant will be accepted as an "associate" student first and will need to take the English test within the first semester (before 15 December 2026). Once the applicant submits the test result, the applicant's status will be changed to a "regular" student.

NIDA reserves the right to examine documents and eligibility of an applicant at any time. If the applicant is found ineligible after being admitted the announcement of acceptance shall be considered null and void.

<u>Note i:</u> Students who pass examination(s) to enter a master degree program at NIDA must pass these English language criteria:

- 1) Students need to submit their score from one of the English proficiency tests namely NIDA TEAP or TOEFL or IELTS to apply for an interview to the program. Students must meet the minimum requirements stipulated by the program.
- 2) Students who are exempted from submitting an English proficiency test score such as students with a scholarship or students of the special program must submit their NIDA TEAP or TOEFL or IELTS score for graduation.

The periods of validity of the test score are as follows:

- 1) NIDA TEAP score is valid for 1 year until the date of submission
- 2) TOEFL and IELTS are valid for 2 years until the date of submission

Enrollment to English for graduate studies courses and the exemption from the courses are determined in compliance with the criteria and requirements stipulated in the English for graduate studies program by the Graduate School of Language and Communication, National Institute of Development Administration.

- 3) Duration, all courses take on 4-5 semesters and 1-2 summer sessions, depending on the area of study / major. All subjects / majors must register 9 credits each semester except the summer session.
 - 4) Tuition fees may change as appropriate according to an announcement by NIDA.

<u>Note ii</u>: Applicants who would like to EXEMPT registration for the English language course (LC4004: Advanced Integrated English) must follow these criteria:

- 1) Applicants must hold a bachelor's and/or master's degree from an international academic institution within the past five years before classes begin; the applicant must obtain a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 from their bachelor's degree and 3.25 from their master's degree, or
- 2) Applicants who are native speakers of English are required to have a residence and permanent residence in an English-speaking country, or
- 3) Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) of 79 for the internet-based test, or 550 for NIDA TOEFL ITP. For IELTS, the minimum score is 6.5. Also, the periods of validity of the test score are 2 years until the first day of the first semester. (TOEFL and IELTS score comparison based on https://www.ets.org)
- 4) Applicants who are exempted from enrolling in the English language course (LC4004: Advanced Integrated English) must request it before the first semester. If the applicants request after enrollment in the English language course, it will accept in case the grade is not shown. Thus, if the applicants receive the grade of the English language course, the exemption would not accept.

2. Application Process

Online Application

2.2 Applicants can visit https://admission.nida.ac.th and must follow the following instructions :

- 1) Select the menu "Login to the System"
- 2) Log in using an email address to receive an OTP (One-Time Password)
- 3) Select the menu "Apply for Admission"
- 4) Choose the program
- 5) Fill out profile information.
- 6) Upload all required application documents.
- 7) Submit the application.
- 8) Pay the application fee of 1,200 Baht

(Payment fee/charge Depends on rate of each payment method /transaction)

- Any branches of Bangkok Bank
- Counter Service in Thailand.
- Internet/Mobile Banking

<u>Note</u>: 1. Applicants can check their payment status, examination date, time and venue, as well as the admission results via the main menu at https://admission.nida.ac.th, according to the schedule specified in the admission announcement.

- 2. The application payment is non-refundable.
- 3. All required application documents must be **uploaded only through the online** admission system.
- 4. In the case of online application, if the applicant fails to upload the required documents, the Institute will consider the application as incomplete, and the applicant will not be eligible for the examination, nor will their name appear on the list of qualified candidates.
- 5. The application is complete when the Institute verifies the application documents and payment made within the prescribed time. Applicants can monitor application status after the payment has been made for 2 day via the main menu at https://admission.nida.ac.th

3. Application Materials

- Two letters of recommendation (Use the standard forms included with the application form)
- Two of 1-inch photos taken not more than six months prior to application date
- Copy of complete official transcript of undergraduate studies (Applicants holding a bachelor's degree (continuing from an Associate's degree) must submit transcripts for both degrees (Bachelor's and Associate's))
- One copy of Identification Card / One copy of Passport
- Evidence of any change of name (if applicable)
- Record of English language proficiency test (TOEFL score or NIDA TEAP or IELTS)
- In cases where the applicant has graduated from an institute outside of Thailand, students must submit:
 - (1) A Letter of Confirmation on Standard Curriculum for Bachelor's Degree

 - (2) An Official Letter of Certification for their Bachelor's Degree Graduation with their University Council's approval as well as a complete transcript with the specified date of graduation which must be sent directly from the applicant's university to the address below:

<u>Note</u>: Applicants must submit all required documents before the interview date or before the first day of classes; otherwise, the application will be considered as incomplete and the application will be void.

Application must ensure that their qualification meets the entrance requirement of the National Institute of Development Administration. It should be noted that application fee is non-refundable if applicant is found eligible for admission.
