The National Institute of Development Administration has revised the Qualification of the Applicants for the Master of Business Administration – International Program Admission as follows:

1. Qualification of the Applicants

1.1 Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in any field or major from an accredited academic institution and have a TOEFL score of 500 PBT, 173 CBT and 61 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 or NIDA TOEFL ITP score of 500 or General English Test from NIDA TEAP score of 500 or

1.2 Applicants who are native speakers of English or who have completed undergraduate studies in English within 5 years prior to application or

1.3 Applicants who have no score from one of the English proficiency tests namely TOEFL score of 500 PBT, 173 CBT and 61 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 or NIDA TOEFL ITP score of 500 or General English Test from NIDA TEAP score of 500 can apply for an interview to the program. The Interview session will be considered with English proficiency. Applicants who have been accepted need to submit their score from one of the English proficiency tests within 6 months from the date of enrollment; otherwise, Applicants will be considered as terminated student.

National Institute of Development Administration New Application for Admission Master of Business Administration – International Program Academic Year 1/2021

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Master of Business Administration – International Program for the academic year 2021.

1. Qualification of the Applicants

1.1 Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in any field or major from an accredited academic institution.

1.2 Applicants must have a TOEFL score of 500 PBT, 173 CBT and 61 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 or NIDA TOEFL ITP score of 500 or General English Test from NIDA TEAP score of 500 or Applicants who are native speakers of English or who have completed undergraduate studies in English within 5 years prior to application.

NIDA reserves the right to examine documents and eligibility of an applicant at any time. If the applicant is found ineligible after being admitted the announcement of acceptance shall be considered null and void.

Note: Students who pass examination(s) to enter a master degree program at NIDA must pass these English language criteria:

1) Students need to submit their score from one of the English proficiency tests namely NIDA TEAP or TOEFL or IELTS to apply for an interview to the program. Students must meet the minimum requirements stipulated by the program.

2) Students who are exempted from submitting an English proficiency test score such as students with a scholarship or students of the special program must submit their NIDA TEAP or TOEFL or IELTS score for graduation.

The periods of validity of the test score are as follows:

- 1) NIDA TEAP score is valid for 1 year until the date of submission
- 2) TOEFL and IELTS are valid for 2 years until the date of submission

Enrollment to English for graduate studies courses and the exemption from the courses are determined in compliance with the criteria and requirements stipulated in the English for graduate studies program by the Graduate School of Language and Communication, National Institute of Development Administration.

3) Duration, All courses take on 4 – 5 semesters and 1 - 2 summer sessions, depending on the area of study / major. All subjects / majors have to register 9 credits each semester except the summer session.

4) Tuition fees may change as appropriate according to an announcement by NIDA.

- 10) If applicants are unable to complete documentation and payment

process by January 29th, 2021 for the first round and June 25th, 2021 for the second round the application will be considered invalid.

Note: 1. The application payment is non-refundable.

2. The application is complete when the Institute verifies the application documents and payment made within the prescribed time.

- Copy of complete official transcript of undergraduate studies (Applicants holding a bachelor's degree (continuing from an Associate's degree) must submit transcripts for both degrees (Bachelor's and Associate's))
- One copy of Identification Card / One copy of Passport
- Evidence of any change of name (if applicable)
- Record of English language proficiency test (TOEFL score or NIDA TEAP or IELTS)
- In cases where the applicant has graduated from an institute outside of Thailand, students must submit:

- (1) A Letter of Confirmation on Standard Curriculum for Bachelor's Degree This can be obtained from the Bureau of Standards and Evaluation at the Commission on Higher Education, Ministry of Education Tel: +66 2 610 5380-2, or contact NIDA's Educational Service Division for more details, 0-2354-5481
- (2) An Official Letter of Certification for their Bachelor's Degree Graduation with their University Council's approval as well as a complete transcript with the specified date of graduation which must be sent directly from the applicant's university to the address below:
