

# ANNOUNCEMENT National Institute of Development Administration Application for Admission Master of Business Administration (English Program Batch #38) For the Academic Year 2/2020 <u>(Written Examination)</u>

The National Institute of Development Administration (NIDA) is accepting applications for admission to the Master of Business Administration (English Program) for the academic year 2/2020.

## **1.** Qualifications of Applicants

1.1 Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in any field or major from an accredited academic institution.

or

1.2 Applicants who are studying in their last semester must graduate with a bachelor's degree on or before the first day of the semester for which they have been accepted.

1.2.1 A complete(final) transcript with the specified date of graduation **<u>must</u> <u>be submitted</u>** on or before the first day of the term for which the applicant has been accepted.

NIDA reserves the right to examine documents and eligibility of an applicant at any time. If the applicant is found ineligible after being admitted the announcement of acceptance shall be considered null and void.

Note : Students who pass examination(s) to enter a master degree program at NIDA must pass these English language criteria:

1) Students need to submit their score from one of the English proficiency tests namely NIDA TEAP or TOEFL or IELTS to apply for an interview to the program. Students must meet the minimum requirements stipulated by the program.

2) Students who are exempted from submitting an English proficiency test score such as students with a scholarship or students of the special program must submit their NIDA TEAP or TOEFL or IELTS score for graduation.

The periods of validity of the test score are as follows: 1) NIDA TEAP score is valid for 1 year until the date of submission 2) TOEFL and IELTS are valid for 2 years until the date of submission Enrollment to English for graduate studies courses and the exemption from the courses are determined in compliance with the criteria and requirements stipulated in the English for graduate studies program by the Graduate School of Language and Communication, National Institute of Development Administration.

3) Duration , All courses take on 4-5 semesters and 1-2 summer sessions, depending on the area of study / major. All subjects / majors have to register 9 credits each semester except the summer session.

4) Tuition fees may change as appropriate according to an announcement by NIDA.

### 2. Selection Procedure

### **2.1 Written Examination**

Qualified applicants must take the NIDA Qualifying Examination which consists of:

Exemptions from *English Communication Skills for Graduate Studies* (LC5030) is as follows:

2.1.1 Applicants admitted to the program who have a TOEFL score of more than 500 but less than 550 must take *English Communication Skills for Graduate Studies* (LC5030).

**Exemptions from LC5030** :Applicants who have a TOEFL score of 550 or higher will be exempted from the *English Communication Skills for Graduate Studies* (LC5030) and from the English Proficiency Test. Applicants who score higher than the Institute's standard requirement on the English Proficiency Test will be exempted from *English Communication Skills for Graduate Studies* (LC5030).

(TOEFL and GMAT scores submitted in support of applications must be from tests taken within two years prior to application to NIDA. Native English speakers, or applicants who have completed undergraduate studies in English–speaking countries within five years prior to application to NIDA are exempted from the LC5030 and English Proficiency Test.)

#### **2.2 Interview**

The admission committee will consider applicants that fulfill who pass the NIDA's Qualifying Examination to be interviewed by the faculty members of the Graduate School of Business Administration.

After the interview, the faculty will convene to review all of the qualified applicants and select those for admission to the program. Applicants who have been accepted into NIDA's English MBA program must submit a complete transcript and the required documents before they commence classes at NIDA. Applicants who fail to submit all required documents will not be admitted to the program.

### **3. Application Process**

#### **<u>3.1 Applying in Person</u>**

- 3) Apply for entrance examination by choosing a school and a program of

study.

- 4) Fill out profile information.
- 5) Confirm the application.
- 6) Print an invoice of application fee.
- 7) Save the application information, verify the information and confirm the application.

9) Print a bill payment for the application and the payment must be made by September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020 for the first round and November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 for the second round only at any branches of Bangkok Bank or Counter Service in Thailand.

Application fee 200 baht for each subject Payment fee/charge Depends on rate of each payment method /transaction

10) If applicants are unable to complete documentation and payment process by September  $25^{\text{th}}$ , 2020 for the first round and November  $6^{\text{th}}$ , 2020 for the second round , the application will be considered invalid.

Note : 1. The application payment is non-refundable.

2. The application is complete when the Institute verifies the application documents and payment made within the prescribed time.

4.5 Complete (final) official transcripts of undergraduate studies (Applicants holding a bachelor's degree(continuing from an Associate's degree) must submit transcripts for both degree(Bachelor's and Associate)).

4.6 Applicants studying in their final semester in a Bachelor's degree program must submit an official letter verifying their status for graduation as well as their transcripts (A complete transcript with the specified date of graduation <u>must be submitted</u> on or before the first day of the term for which the applicant has been accepted).

4.7 Evidence of any change of name (if applicable).

- 4.8 In cases where the applicant has graduated from an institute outside Thailand, students must submit:
  - A Letter of Confirmation on Standard Curriculum for Bachelor's Degree.
