Prior to joining CEIBS, she was Professor of Management in the Department of Management and Marketing and James Riady Chair in Asian Business and Economics at University of Melbourne. She is serving as the Editor-in-Chief of *Asia Pacific Journal of Management*.

Dr. Lu received her Ph.D. in General Management from University of Western Ontario, MBA from CEIBS. Her current research primarily focuses on international strategy such as FDI

location choice, entry mode choice and alliance partner selection. Her recent research continues this line of research but with a focus on emerging market firms and their internationalization.
